

Awareness Programme on Anti-Ragging

Sri. D. Ravi Babu, Asst. Commissioner of Police (Law & Order), Madhurawada Region, Visakhapatnam addressed all the second year engineering students at ANITS. He gave a talk on "Awareness Programme on Anti-Ragging" on the 1st of August 2015.

He started by explaining the importance of education for a bright and fruitful career. He stressed that the parents efforts for the students career was of utmost value as it would help the students to achieve their goals easily. Students on their part need to work hard and accomplish their tasks on time. He further stated that professional ethics and human values of education play a very vital role in shaping the attitude of the students. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has brought out an act on Anti-Ragging to eradicate the menace in 1997.

Ragging is termed as any activity which causes or is likely to cause fear, apprehension, and intimidation to students. The Commissioner elucidated on the A.P. 'Anti-Ragging Act Sec-4' and said that teasing, embarrassing or humiliating students would incur punishment of upto 6 months in jail and a penalty of Rs. 1000/-. The punishment and penalty would go up according to the severity of the crimes committed by the students against their juniors.

He emphasized that Management shall enquire or call for enquiry on ragging, if found guilty, the institution has the authority to suspend the student. He warned the students to be aware of the legal implications about ragging.

As a parent and a common man the ACP requested the students to give importance to human values and ethics so as to protect the integrity of the student, his family and the institution.

He made the students undertake an oath on behalf of the Anti-Ragging awareness programme. He advised the student to take part in social activities and struggle for the welfare of the Nation by appearing for civil services.

The Principal, Prof. V.S.R.K. Prasad stated that ANITS was taking all precautionary measures to prevent ragging. Several banners have been placed at various places to create awareness among the students. An anti-ragging committee and squad have been formed to look in to the students' problems, if any. Faculty members have been given task of maintaining visits at every block during arrival, leaving, lunch break and short breaks. The Principal stated that the college has never faced any issue regarding ragging because of all these precautionary measures. He thanked the ACP for visiting the college and addressing the students. He appreciated the efforts of the ACP in creating awareness on Ragging of the repercussion that the student should have to face if found guilty.

Dr. Raja Rao, HoD, EEE Department, Convener of the Anti-Ragging Committee, presented an annual report by stating that ANITS is very particular that no ragging activity takes place on campus and quoted that the Institution was bound by "Zero tolerance to Ragging".

Activity / Process	Attributes

This course help to train students for Group discussions and job Interviews which improves their employability skills and facilitate them in setting realistic goals and achieving them using time management techniques.
N S S activities	Various activities under NSS are aimed at developing student's personality through community service , instills the idea of social welfare in students, and to provide service to society without bias. It organizes blood donation camps and also provides help in natural and man-made disasters by providing food, clothing and first aid to the disaster victims.
Yoga & Guest lectures on personality development	Motivational lectures and workshops about life, yoga, meditation, etc. by Brahma Kumaris Mission, Akshya Patra, Art of Living, etc. are organized to rejuvenate or bring relief to students and enhance self confidence , life skills .
